BRUSH CHIPPING PROGRAM UPDATE

The Village of Anmore will no longer be offering a roadside Brush Chipping Service Program to its residents.

At the Regular Council Meeting held on November 15, 2016 (see Page 4 R222/2016):

It was MOVED and SECONDED:

“THAT THE VILLAGE OF ANMORE BI-ANNUAL BRUSH CHIPPING PROGRAM BE ELIMINATED DUE TO LACK OF COMMUNITY PARTICIPATION, THE COST ASSOCIATED WITH PROVIDING THE SERVICE, AND THE ABILITY FOR RESIDENTS TO USE THEIR KITCHEN AND YARD WASTE COLLECTION CARTS TO DISPOSE OF BRUSH CLIPPINGS.”

CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY

Important: Council will be considering alternatives and will provide details to residents once available.

Note: The Brush Chipping Program had originally been implemented prior to the bi-weekly green waste collection (c/o Smithrite Disposal Services) which provides an alternative to residents (for acceptable materials).

There were only a small group of residents that participated in the brush chipping program and it was a very costly service.

It will be each homeowner's responsibility to arrange for their yard waste materials to be disposed of appropriately.
