



# VILLAGE OF ANMORE CALL FOR VOLUNTEERS

Anmore Council is recruiting volunteers to serve on the following advisory bodies.

## **ADVISORY PLANNING COMMISSION (APC)**

Provides recommendations to Council on matters respecting land use, community planning, and/or proposed bylaws and permits. | Seven (7) members required for a two-year term, expiring December 31, 2019. | Meetings are held on the second Monday at 7:00 p.m. at village hall (monthly, as required).

## **BOARD OF VARIANCE**

Operates independently from Council, with resource support from municipal staff, and responds to appeals on the interpretation and application of the municipal zoning bylaw, and rules on applications pursuant to the *Local Government Act*. Decisions are primarily focused on hardship situations involving siting, dimensions and building size. | Three (3) members are required, to serve for a three-year term expiring December 31, 2020. | Meetings are held as required, in consideration of member availability. | Note: Members of APC, Council or Anmore staff are not permitted to sit on the Board of Variance.

## **COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT, CULTURE, AND INCLUSION COMMITTEE**

Provides recommendations to Council on matters respecting Council Policy, preserving Anmore's heritage, social programs, and community involvement designed to foster community engagement. | One (1) member is required to complete the committee complement for the term expiring March 31, 2019. | Meetings are held on the second Thursday at 7:00 p.m. at village hall (monthly, as required).

## **YOUTH COMMITTEE**

Helps to organize activities to encourage opportunities for youth engagement in and around the community and provide advice on Council Policy, as requested. | Up to three (3) additional youth members in the age range of 13 to 19 years old are required to serve for all or part of the term expiring on March 31, 2019. | Meetings are held monthly on the third Sunday after bingo night at village hall, and youth events are held as organized.
