



The Village of Anmore is developing an Emergency Social Services (ESS) Program. We require 3-4 volunteers for the provision of Emergency Social Services in case of an emergency.

The ESS program helps people affected by large community wide emergencies such as earthquakes as well as smaller individual emergencies such as house fires or floods.

ESS volunteers assist individuals that become displaced from their homes and provide essential basic needs such as:

- Food and shelter
- Clothing and supplies
- Emotional and health services
- Child minding and pet care
- Transportation
