HAL WEINBERG SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Community Volunteering – Total 5 points

- 5pts Serve one or more term(s) on the Anmore Youth Committee
- 4pts 50+ Volunteering Hours in Anmore
- 3pts 10-50 Volunteering Hours in Anmore
- 2pts 50+ Any Volunteering Hours
- 1pts 1-50 Any Volunteering Hours

- The Village may vet the number of volunteer hours performed in Anmore

Academic Achievement – Total of 4 Points

Calculate the percentage average of **ALL** Grade 11 and 12 courses.

- 4pts 91%+
- 3pts 86% to 90%
- 2pts 76% to 85%
- 1pt 70% to 75%

Extra-Curricular Activities – Total of 4 Points

Only activities during Grade 11 and 12 will be considered. A **MAXIMUM** of 4 points can be achieved. Points can be achieved for each activity the applicant has participated in, for example, 2 sports equals 4 points).

- 2pts For having a part-time job
- 2pts For participating in a sport, organized physical activity or band/music program
- 1pt For participating in any other organized activity

Letter of Future Plans – Total of 2 Points

- 2pts For a well-written, professional letter
- 1pt For submitting a letter that attempts to meet the criteria
