

Payment Options for Property Taxes and Utility Invoices

Payment can be made via the following means:

- Cheque (or post-dated cheque) – payable to “**VILLAGE OF ANMORE**”
- Money Order or Bank Draft – payable to “**VILLAGE OF ANMORE**”
- Debit card / Interac
- Online Banking
- Cash

Note: Credit cards are NOT accepted as a form of payment.

Type of Payment		Description
1.	Online Banking	<p>To pay your PROPERTY TAXES ONLINE, access your personal online banking and add Village of Anmore (or alternate Village payee reference as noted below) as a payee using the folio number (roll number without dashes) where the account number is requested. Remember to complete the online Home Owner Grant at www.anmore.com (if eligible).</p> <p>To pay your UTILITY INVOICE ONLINE, access your personal online banking and add Village of Anmore (or alternate Village payee reference as noted below) as a payee using the utility account number (account number without dashes) where the account number is requested.</p> <p>Note: Payee name can vary with financial institutions. Village of Anmore; Anmore, Village of; Anmore Village, etc. (should you have difficulty finding Anmore as a payee, please contact your financial institution directly to enquire).</p>
2.	Pre-Authorized Withdrawal	<p>Enrol in our monthly Pre-Authorized Debit Plan (PAD) program for <u>future</u> billings (Property Taxes and/or Utility Invoices). Current and prior year property taxes/utilities must be paid in full prior to enrolling. Visit www.anmore.com for further info.</p>
3.	Pay in Person	<p>Be prepared to wait in line the week before payment is due. Prior to visiting the office to make a payment using Interac, please contact your financial institution to ensure the transaction limit amount is sufficient. Post-dated cheques will be accepted and the cancelled cheque is your receipt.</p> <p>Payment options: Cheque, Interac, Money Order, Bank Draft, Cash</p>
4.	By Mail	<p>For Property Taxes only: Ensure the Home Owner Grant is completed in full or complete the online Home Owner Grant at www.anmore.com instead (if eligible).</p> <p>Note: All cheques must be received by the deadline date noted on your Property Tax Notice or Utility Invoice to avoid the applicable penalty. *Envelope Postmarks* will not be considered as date of payment.</p> <p>Payment options: Cheque only (no cash)</p>
5.	Drop off at Village Hall Drop Box	<p>A mail slot (secure drop box) has been installed for your convenience in the main door at the Village Hall office.</p> <p>For Property Taxes only: Ensure the Home Owner Grant is completed in full or complete the online Home Owner Grant at www.anmore.com instead (if eligible).</p> <p>Payment options: Cheque only (no cash)</p>
