#### 6. NEW BUSINESS

##### (a) Adopt-A-Street Program

The following points were highlighted during discussion about this matter:

- Members viewed and discussed the map for eligible streets to adopt
- Only require “basic” equipment such as vests, bags etc. for participants to use
- \$50.00 per person for equipment costs; village covers
- An “adopt a street” sign will be erected for each participant
- Hoping it will bring the community together
- Program was introduced at Ma Murray Day
- Members were happy with the final program

**(b) Safe Trail Use at Buntzen Lake**

The following points were highlighted during discussion about this matter:

- Encourage safe use of the trails with more signage, good quality map at beginning of a trail, identifiable markers at the trail heads; where you are, timelines, areas with good cell phone reception.
- Could all be incorporated into a detailed map
- Include information about being prepared in the trails such as, proper foot wear, water, plan accordingly if going further up into hills
- Fire department responds to around 3 to 10 calls per year for people on the trail
- A member felt there were enough call outs from the fire department to justify improving the safety around trails.
- Too difficult to include all the different languages; use icons for water bottles, running shoes, backpacks, blankets etc.
- Speak with the app creator of “All Trails” to include Buntzen Lake trails
- Possibly incorporate directional signs for those areas that aren’t clear
- Timeline signage; halfway there, or almost there?
- Possibly incorporate nighttime reflectors
