Garbage & Green Waste

1. Keep garbage in the house, garage or shed until pick-up day
2. Clean your bins regularly and store in a secure location
3. Don't add meat products or cooked food to your personal compost, turn it regularly and keep it covered
4. Freeze smelly food scraps in a container or bag until collection day

Fruit Trees

5. Pick ripe and fallen fruit daily
6. Remove unused fruit trees

Pet Food

7. Bring pet dishes inside and clean up any spillage
8. Store pet food indoors

Barbeque

9. Clean BBQ grill after each use
10. Store BBQ covered in a secure area

Birds

11. Use birdfeeders only in the winter
12. Keep ground free of seeds

DID YOU KNOW?
Each year in BC, nearly 1,000 bears are destroyed due to conflicts between people and bears!

How do water meters help conserve water?

Water meters make people aware about their water use. When people are charged for their actual measured use, they tend not to waste it, thereby reducing their overall water consumption. In addition to helping the environment and the benefits to society as a whole, Anmore residents can save on their water bills.

What are some ways to check my water meter and how can I save more money?

You are encouraged to schedule your own monthly water meter checks to detect possible leaks in your home. To check for a possible leak, (1) make sure no water is being used inside or outside of your house (i.e. dishwasher, faucet, washing machine, sprinklers, etc.), (2) shut off your main water valve, (3) locate your water meter (most often located at your property line outside your home), and (4) check to see if the leak indicator is moving. If so, you may have a leak to investigate.
