



Q1 Did you attend Light Up Spirit Park Holiday Celebration in December 2019?





Q2 If No - why not?





Q3 How did you hear about the Light Up Spirit Park event?









Q6 Did you attend Ma Murray Day in September 2019?





Q7 If no - Why not?





Q8 If yes - How did you hear about the Ma Murray Day event?











- 2. Flea markets, arts and crafts shows, (more events like Ma Murray Day), more (small) kid friendly events.
- 3. People with mobility difficulties need parking that is close to the event and places to sit at the event. I have mentioned this in the past but no accommodations have been made.
- 4. All in all I am very impressed with the community in Anmore. It's been so nice getting to know it.
- 5. Parking is an issue.
- 6. Kudos to those that plan and execute these events. I think they are wonderful for the community.
- 7. Community Garage Sale.
- 8. It would be helpful if you had a more specific agenda of what times things were happening and more details. At 'Light Up Spirit Park' the kids wanted to go on the carriage ride but it was already sold out (and we had never been before so we had no idea of where to buy tickets or that you had to get there really early to do so). Wasn't really much to do there once you had looked at the lights would have stayed for carollers but didn't know when that was happening so we left after about 20 minutes. Underwhelming.
- 9. Yoga in the park would be great considering we have a well-respected yogi who lives and practices in Anmore.
- 10. Music in the park would be great, an outdoor movie night, education/info nights, an evening adult flashlight egg hunt and social (with good prize incentives!), a bonfire night.
- 11. When my kids attended Anmore Elementary, I felt part of the community. That community sense is now missing. Offering community social events ie: adult fitness activities, info nights followed by social time, book exchanges, recipe exchanges, etc. Just providing an opportunity to connect again.
- 12. Set-up for Ma Murray had booths on the lower field where no one could hear anything from the sound system. How about a pancake breakfast at the school maybe before the Terry Fox run we did it for the Olympics. Light-up should be on a Saturday with more activities before, but if the weather is awful, people probably won't attend. Don't expect folks to stay after the lights come on especially on a school night or if the weather is bad. Anmore used to have a really big tent, it would be good to have another on for sun/rain cover.

- 25. Playing cards or board games singles or couples, tennis league, community Scavenger hunt, pancake breakfasts or brunch to fundraise.
