(a) Public Safety for Pedestrians and Bicycles

Chair Laidler read aloud a letter written by a concerned resident, regarding a recommendation for a crosswalk (with flashing lights) to be installed on Sunnyside Road at Alpine Drive.

Chair Laidler invited any members of the public attending to provide public input:

Nancy Maloney, Anmore, spoke regarding pedestrian safety, request for additional crosswalk on East Road, and speed concerns.

Committee members discussed several safety concerns related to pedestrian and bicycle movement throughout the Village.

The following points were highlighted during discussion about policing in Anmore:

- Speed Watch
- Review of both daytime and evening safety concerns
- Traffic study on major roads, including MRN-TransLink roads
- Improvements to enforcement
- Increase in community awareness
- Consideration of community engagement strategies for pedestrian safety and lighting with consideration of dark sky principles
