## INSTRUCTIONS

### To request a mail ballot:

2. If your application is complete and you qualify to vote by mail ballot, a mail ballot package will be sent to you as soon as the ballots are available, no sooner than September 26, 2022. Mail ballot applications will be accepted until noon October 12, 2022. If we receive your application after noon on October 3, 2022, the time may be insufficient for mailing and receipt of the ballot; we recommend that you arrange to pick up a mail ballot package from the Anmore Village Hall.
3. You are responsible for ensuring that your completed ballot and documents are received by the chief election officer on October 15, 2022 before the close of voting at 8 p.m.

Identification must be provided at time of pick up and a declaration signed by the person picking up the ballot.

## I hereby declare that I am:

- 18 years of age or older on general voting day October 15, 2022; and
- a Canadian citizen; and
- a resident of British Columbia for at least six months immediately before the day of voter registration; and
- a resident of the municipality; OR  
a non-resident owner of real property in the municipality for at least 30 days immediately before the day of voter registration; and
- not disqualified by law from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law.
