

The \$1,000 Hal Weinberg Scholarship is awarded annually to a Grade 12 student who is a resident of Anmore, graduating from high school and continuing on to post secondary education. The recipient will have one year to enroll into the post-secondary institution of their choice. Proof of enrollment must be provided prior to disbursing the \$1,000 scholarship.

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Using the point system below, the scholarship is awarded based on community volunteering, academic achievements, extra-curricular activities and future plans.

COMMUNITY VOLUNTEERING: TOTAL 5 POINTS

5 points	50+ Volunteering hours in Anmore* including service on Anmore Youth Committee
3 points	10-50 Volunteering hours in Anmore*
2 points	50+ Any volunteering hours
1 point	1-50 Any volunteering hours

* The Village may vet the number of volunteer hours performed in Anmore

ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT: TOTAL OF 4 POINTS

Calculate percentage of ALL Grade 11 and 12 courses.

4 points	91% +
3 points	86-90%
2 points	76-85%
1 point	70-75%

EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES: TOTAL OF 4 POINTS

Only activities during Grade 11 and 12 will be considered, up to a MAXIMUM of 4 points. Points can be achieved for each activity the applicant has participated in, for example, 2 sports equals 4 points.

2 points	For having a part-time job
2 points	For participating in a sport, organized physical activity or band/music program
1 point	For participating in any other organized activity

LETTER OF FUTURE PLANS – TOTAL OF 2 POINTS

2 points	For a well-written, professional letter
1 point	For submitting a letter that attempts to meet the criteria

Scholarship applications received by **Sunday, May 7, 2023** will be reviewed and graded by Mayor and Council using the point system on this page. Consideration of applications is scheduled to take place in May 2023 and announcement on the scholarship award recipient/recipients will follow. Successful recipient/recipients will be invited to a future Regular Council Meeting (date TBD) for the official announcement.
