BYLAW NO.25

A Bylaw Prohibiting Littering of Highways

The Council of the Village of Anmore hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS.

1. In this Bylaw:

"Rubbish" includes but is not limited to bottles, glass containers or other articles, whether broken or intact, paper or plastic products.

2. No person shall litter any highway or public place in the Village of Anmore with any rubbish.

3. Any person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw commits an offence and is liable upon conviction to a fine of not less than \$100.00 and not more than the maximum penalties provided by the "Offence Act".

4. This bylaw may be cited as "Anmore Littering Bylaw No. 25, 1989".

READ A SECOND TIME this 23rd day of January , 1989.


