VILLAGE OF ANMORE

BYLAW NO.25

A Bylaw Prohibiting Littering of Highways

The Council of the Village of Anmore hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS.

1. In this Bylaw:

"Rubbish" includes but is not limited to bottles, glass containers or other articles, whether broken or intact, paper or plastic products.

- 2. No person shall litter any highway or public place in the Village of Anmore with any rubbish.
- 3. Any person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw commits an offence and is liable upon conviction to a fine of not less than \$100.00 and not more than the maximum penalties provided by the "Offence Act".
- 4. This bylaw may be cited as "Anmore Littering Bylaw No. 25___, 1989".
