ADVISORY PLANNING COMMISSION

The term for the Advisory Planning Commission will end January 31, 2026.

Matters respecting land use, community planning, or proposed bylaws and permits.

BOARD OF VARIANCE COMMITTEE

an autonomous body with the authority to vary requirements of the Zoning Bylaw, within statutory limits.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT, CULTURE, AND INCLUSION COMMITTEE

Matters respecting age-friendly policies, services, and programs, development of an accessibility plan, preserving Anmore's heritage, social programs, and community involvement designed to foster community engagement. Per Section 9 of the *Accessible British Columbia Act*, the committee should reflect the diversity of persons with disabilities in BC. The committee will be comprised of at least four persons with disabilities or individuals who support persons with disabilities or represent organizations that support persons with disabilities, at least one Indigenous community member, and one community member at large.

ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE

Matters respecting environmental issues, which may include areas of concern related to development and re-development proposals.

PARKS AND RECREATION COMMITTEE

Matters respecting community parks, trails, sports and recreation.

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE

Matters respecting the welfare and protection of the community's residents and its visitors.
