SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a Grade 12 student residing in Anmore and graduating from high school.
- Must have plans to pursue post-secondary education. Recipients must enroll in a post-secondary institution within one year and provide proof of enrollment to receive the scholarship.

Community Service:

- Applicants should demonstrate exceptional community service in Anmore, including volunteer hours. Volunteering specifically within Anmore or with the Anmore Youth Group is highly valued.
- Nominees must demonstrate proof of their academic achievements as well as their extra-curricular activities.

Application Must Include:

- A personal letter outlining how you meet the scholarship criteria, your future plans and how you would utilize the scholarship
- A letter of reference from the applicant's school, verifying your qualifications.
- A copy of the applicant's interim transcript, covering both Grade 11 and Grade 12. If your interim transcript is not available, please submit the most up-to-date school records and report cards.
- A completed application form, detailing all necessary personal and academic information.

APPLICATION CONSIDERATION

Scholarship applications received by **Friday, May 16, 2025** will be selected by Council in a Closed Meeting following the application deadline. Council may decide not to award the scholarship in a given year, or to divide the scholarship between multiple recipients. Only successful applicants will be contacted.
