PARK EXPANSION PROJECT: Dr. Hal Weinberg Spirit Park



Dr. Hal Weinberg Spirit Park is Anmore's primary outdoor community gathering space and we are working on a plan to expand the park to include the Village's empty lot on Ravenswood and incorporate this outdoor recreation area with the Anmore Community Hub.

An expanded park concept map has been developed, which notes design elements that are already complete based on engineering and technical analysis, such as the road alignment and parking area design and access points. We have also confirmed amenities such as the gazebo and plaza.

The suggested areas and amenities shown on the concept plan are just ideas for consideration at this point. We are inviting our community to share your input on a future vision for this park. This is just phase one of engagement, and input from the community will be used along with technical assessments and budget considerations to help plan the expanded park.

The following renderings illustrate a few conceptual ideas of what the park could become.









PARK EXPANSION DRAFT CONCEPT PLAN

The concept plan includes both confirmed design elements and suggested ideas for how the expanded park could be designed.

The completed upper parking lot includes accessible and electric vehicle parking.

Expanded parking has 50+ parking stalls (including two accessible spots) for everyday public use. Wide lanes can accommodate food truck event parking and emergency vehicles.

Open Lawn

This space could be used as an active park that incorporates replanting of native trees suitable and adaptive to the soil conditions. Please share your input on potential active park amenities and how this space could be used.

The Hub can accommodate events of up to 330 people in the community room and is also the Village Hall.

The plaza is an outdoor event space with step seating that is connected to the Hub to provide an additional area for the community to gather.

The open lawn is primarily in the existing area for Dr. Hal Weinberg Spirit Park, and the gazebo will remain in the same location. Please share your input on ideas for amenities in this area.

Natural Forest

The pedestrian path meanders

through the entire park as a walking

circuit through all spaces and features.

Plaza

The playground area includes seating decks and bark mulch surfacing.
The area will be level with a downslope embankment towards the meadow area. Please share your input on the ideas for playground equipment.

This space could be a naturalized area with meadow grass that would require minimal maintenance. Please share your input on how this area could be used.

This space could be a natural forest, with native trees that are suitable and adaptive to the soil conditions. This area could also have a pedestrian path. Please share your input on how this area could be used.
