

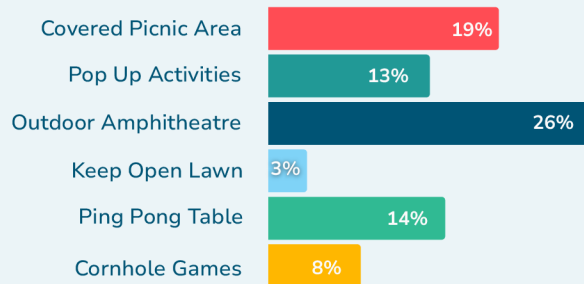
Weinberg Park Expansion Phase 1 Results

In April 2025, residents provided feedback both in person (at the Easter Event) and online. They voted on proposed ideas for five park 'focus' areas: open lawn, natural forest, active park area, playground, meadow area and contributed new suggestions.

Open Lawn

Total votes: 160 (135 in-person, 25 online)

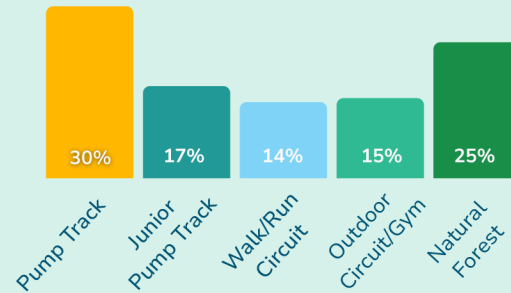
Insight: Preferences suggest a desire for informal gathering spaces and accessible outdoor activities.



Active Park – Results Summary

Total votes: 139 (122 in-person, 17 online)

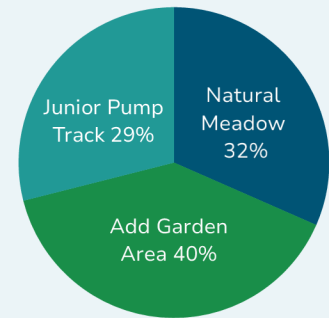
Insight: There are mixed opinions on active recreation versus natural spaces; while support exists for adult and junior pump tracks, many prefer restoring the area to forest.



Meadow Area: Results Summary

Total votes: 76 (62 in-person, 14 online)

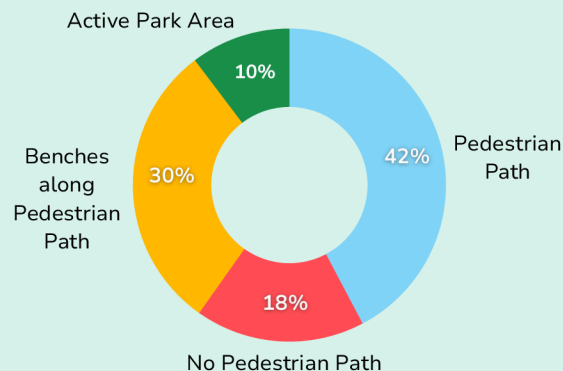
Insight: Feedback indicates a balanced preference for either adding a garden or preserving the space, with support for a junior pump track by the playground.



Natural Forest:

Total votes: 97 (83 in-person, 14 online)

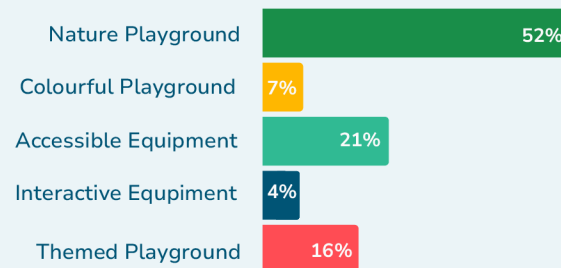
Insight: There is strong support for creating accessible trails and quiet resting areas. However, a notable portion of respondents prefer to keep it natural.



Playground Equipment:

Total votes: 119 (105 in-person, 14 online)

Insight: Natural-style playgrounds with inclusive equipment are strongly preferred. Themed playgrounds have moderate interest but are less favored.



Top New Ideas:

Total votes: 113 (106 in-person, 7 online)

Insight: Several innovative ideas have emerged. Some can be integrated into phase two, while others are impractical due to infrastructure limitations.
