To request a mail ballot:

2. If your application is complete and you qualify to vote by mail ballot, a mail ballot package will be sent to you as soon as the ballots are available. If we receive your application after September 30, 2026, the time may be insufficient for mailing and receipt of the ballot; we recommend that you arrange to pick up a mail ballot package from the Anmore Village Hall after this date.
3. You are responsible for ensuring that your completed ballot and documents are received by the chief election officer on or before October 17, 2026, before the close of voting at 8 p.m.
